How do I know if my membership is up to date?

Beginning with the Winter 2003 newsletter, the mailing label will give you information about your Society membership status. Above your name and address, there is a Code line similar to

that shown in the block at right.

The Code line is deciphered as follows:

cipient's zip or postal code. The "S" shown in the Code line example above indicates that this member is a sustaining / contributing member. Other codes are P for individual member, F for a family member, M for lifetime member and X for a Society membership donation.

The final code is a date, as in the example above—6/30/2004. This date indicates when your membership expires. If the date shown on your label has passed, then your membership dues are not current.

Hopefully this system will help everyone know their standing in the Society.
